

PARISH LIFE MINISTRY

Social Committee: Volunteers that provides social opportunities for St. Andrew; coffee and doughnuts, breakfast's, dinners, church celebrations, and funerals. More "younger legs and minds" would help this group continue its ministry to create Christian fellowship in serving food at parish events.

Mowing Ministry: a volunteer group that keeps our lawns well groomed and trimmed.

Maintenance Ministry: a volunteer group that takes care of some of our maintenance requests. They help keep our grounds green, taking care of litter, recycling cans, supervises those who serve community service and many other tasks to help our paid maintenance staff.

Garden Ministry: A group of volunteers to continue to support our schools garden. (A new seed possibility – could be for someone to develop and organize a very large garden for the parish, neighborhood. etc, as a money maker or outreach project. This endeavor would require a leader with time, equipment and the desire to grow and manage a large garden.)

Parish Office Volunteers/weekday, Saturday: Weekday volunteers provide extra office services. Saturday volunteers fold bulletins for Mass and for mailing to homebound parishioners.

Reach Out/Bulletin/Mailings Volunteers: Announcements for the bulletin and announcements and articles for the *Reach Out* our newsletter are welcome from parish committees and individual members. The *Reach Out* is published three times a year.

Parish Night Out: A monthly meal, usually meeting in a restaurant the third Sunday evening, to socialize with fellow parishioners and friends of all ages.

Phone Tree/email Tree: Contacts signed up parishioners about parish deaths, Mass cancellations. Add your name to list and/or help make calls. Give your request to be emailed and your email to the email chairperson.

Half-Century Club: A group of parish friends over age 50 who meet the second Sunday of the month to socialize during games, meals or entertainment outings.

Other Ministries: Your suggestions for an additional program or ministry you are interested in starting and developing are welcome.

Each of the six ministries will have an annual commission meeting, headed by a parish council representative and chairpersons from the different committees, groups or ministries.
