

SERVICE AND FAMILY MINISTRY

Homebound Ministers: There are many volunteer opportunities to minister; Homebound Eucharist Ministry, visitor, phone, letter or card greeter, or a volunteer that helps by taking food, helping clean, getting groceries, giving a ride, etc. Our homebound parishioners can write letters, send cards, and offer prayers for others.

Bereavement Sunshine Group: Ministers write letters, make visits, and send cards, flowers, etc to the spouses or family members of those recently gone to heaven.

Teen Ministry: Fellowship activities of teens accomplish spiritual growth, service and social goals at gatherings and after and during High School Religious Education. Teens prepare providing leadership at fifth week of the month Sunday Masses. Parental team offers guidance, transportation and help with fundraising. The North Deanery parishes provide additional youth ministry experiences for our teens.

Young Adult Ministry (ages 18-35): Volunteer young adults are needed to get this ministry started. Let us know if you are interested in being a part of this ministry of young adults. You can make a difference. You are needed at St. Andrew. There are many groups beginning in our parishes and frequently meet with the Archdiocesan Young Adult Ministry consisting of over 200 young adults.

Single's Ministry (ages 30 and up): Volunteer singles are needed to get this ministry started, let us know if you are interested in being a part of this ministry of single adults. This group is for single, unmarried, divorced, separated, or widowed adults. You can have a home at St. Andrew.

Knights of Peter Claver: Members support and participate in parish programs, encouraging civic improvement, academic scholarship, lay Catholic action and youth recreational facilities.

Ladies of Peter Claver: Members support and participate in parish programs, encouraging civic improvement, academic scholarship, lay Catholic action and youth recreational facilities.

CYO: Provides teamwork experience through youth athletic competition; adult coaches and other volunteers support our parish children and those in our school with CYO organizational efforts.
