Dear Friends,

In the First Reading this week, Moses speaks with authority. He tells the chosen people, "A prophet like me will the Lord, your God, raise up for you from among your own kin; to whom you shall listen."

In the Gospel, Jesus astonished the people with his teaching, and he amazed them as "he commands even unclean spirits and they obey him." Jesus teaches with outstanding authority.

We are called to follow Jesus just as St. Andrew. To follow Jesus, we too, are called to astonish people with his teaching and amaze people as we live these teachings with authority.

St. Paul speaks of the single life and how to live. One who is single should be "anxious about the things of the Lord" and should live for the Lord. St. Paul also speaks of each spouse who is married and how they should live. One who is married must be concerned for spouse and family, yet, and in so doing, one lives entirely for the Lord.

We use the gifts and strengths God gave us as we live our lives using them humbly and compassionately. We live our lives following Christ with authority; the authority to witness his teachings in our words, but most amazingly with our deeds.

When we live with this authority of our Divine Teacher, we truly, humbly, and compassionately, astonish and amaze others with the presence of God manifested. We even astonish and amaze ourselves as we live for the Lord, sharing our lives with our kin, our brothers and sisters.
